

#### Short information about the conference

The 20th anniversary of John Paul II's third stay in Croatia is this year. During this time, the Pope visited five cities: Rijeka, Dubrovnik, Osijek, Dakovo and Zadar. It was the third and last trip to Croatia and the hundredth apostolic journey of John Paul II as a pilgrim.

The first visit, in 1994 to Zagreb, was mainly to celebrate the 900th anniversary of the Archdiocese of Zagreb and to send a message of peace to the war being waged by Serbs in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The main purpose of John Paul II's second visit to Croatia was the beatification of Alojzije Stepinac, a martyr of communist times, which was performed by the Pope on October 3, 1998, in the sanctuary of Our Lady of the Snows in Marija Bistrica. This event was documented, among others, in the Sanctuary of John Paul II in Krakow, where there is a chapel - a mosaic called the Croatian Oratory, depicting the Virgin Mary with Baby Jesus from the sanctuary of Marija Bistrica in Croatia, next to the figures of Cardinal Alojzije Stepinac and Pope John Paul II. The Croatian Oratory was established on the initiative of the honorary consul of the Republic of Croatia in Krakow, with the consent of the Krakow Church and with the support of the Croatian Church, on the 20th anniversary of this event.

Taking into account the three visits of the Polish Pope to Croatia, those extraordinary times and the little knowledge of the Polish society on this subject, the consulate of the Republic of Croatia in Krakow decided to organize a conference to familiarize the Polish society with the closeness of John Paul II with the Croatian nation.

The conference is organized under the title "Croatian relations of John Paul II in memories, on the 20th anniversary of the third pilgrimage to Croatia and the hundredth in the world as a pilgrim pope" on October 23, 2023.

The conference will be held on October 23, 2023, in the auditorium of the Pontifical University of John Paul II, on Bernadyńska Str. 3 in Krakow.
